

In English, we have been working on writing personal letters. In our letters, we will tell the people of the future about living in 2013.




The structure of a personal letter is very similar to a recount because it has an introduction, body and conclusion.




### LOTE by Joel & Zane

After the story, we learnt how to make a paper crane. We have also been doing a lot of work on the grammar in the Japanese language.

## Science by Aylish & Shannon

Our class are currently doing a unit called 'May the Force be with you'. We have been investigating air buggies, pendulums and falling objects.



Last week, we reviewed the forces acting on an airplane - gravity, lift, thrust and drag. Gravity is the force that pulls objects towards the earth. Lift opposes gravity. Drag is the opposing force of thrust. Thrust is produced by the plane's engine and propellers while the Bernoulli Effect creates lift. The higher air pressure below the wings acts against the lower air pressure above to create lift.

### Maths by Rick & Kobe

This term, we are preparing for the Maths Teams Challenge being held on 28 August. Our focus has been on problem-solving. Each week, we are doing a number review on fractions and percentages, square and cube roots, factors and multiples, and operations.

### Music by Nikita & Brooke

We are learning how to play the glockenspiel in Music with Mrs Brown. Also singing songs and music games.
