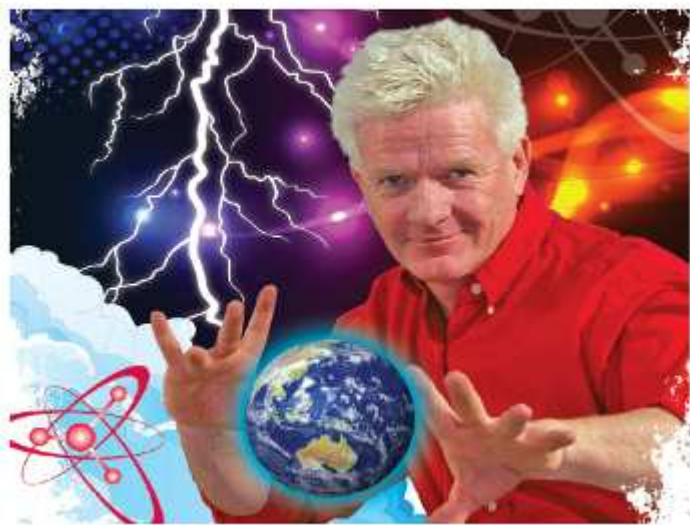
Crazy Science: The Crazy Scientist Strikes Back
