- achieve National Minimum Standard (NMS) in Literacy and Numeracy for their year level; or
- have an evidence based learning plan in place to address their specific learning needs.

Kolan South will achieve these outcomes in **Reading** and **Numeracy** in 2018:

- achieve a Mean Scaled Score at on or above the National Mean for Years 3 and 5;
- maintain the percentage of Year 3 and Year 5 students in the U2B at greater than 40%.

## Our initiatives include

### Professional Development

- Build teacher capability in explicit teaching and consolidations through coaching and instructional leadership. Classroom release for classroom teachers to engage in activities.
- Enhance the skills of staff in monitoring and assessment of student performance data in Reading and Numeracy, and performance data management.
