- Achieve NMS in Literacy and Numeracy for their year level or
- Have an evidence based learning plan in place to address their specific learning needs.

Kolan South will achieve these outcomes in Reading and Numeracy in 2017:

- Achieve a Mean Scaled Score at on or above the National Mean for Year 3 and 5.
- Maintain the % of Year 3 and Year 5 students in the Upper 2 Bands (U2B) at > 40%.

## Our initiatives include

### Professional Development

- Building teacher capability in explicit teaching and consolidations through coaching and instructional leadership. Classroom release for classroom teachers to engage in activities.
- Enhancing the skills of staff in monitoring and assessment of student performance data in Reading and Numeracy and performance data management.
- Training staff to implement Reading Links program.

### Human Resources

- Provision of targeted Teacher Aide time to support differentiated learning within classrooms.
- Provision of teacher release to support coaching and feedback processes in literacy and numeracy.
- Provision of resources to support reading development of targeted students.
